

I just got a job-can I keep filing til I get paid?

Good news! You got a job. Payday doesn't come for a couple of weeks. But, if you are working fulltime, you should not be requesting benefits.

Any time you work your customary hours for a week or earn twice your weekly benefit amount, you will not be payable.

You must report hours and earnings honestly. Failure to do so means you will be prosecuted for fraud.

If you are working only part time and less than your customary hours, then you can request partial benefits. You should continue to look for work each week, unless you are job or union attached.

If you find a job and are not filing for benefits, you don't need to report anything or notify anyone. You stop doing the biweekly filing, and your claim becomes inactive.
