<u>ISSUE:</u> Whether the Hearing Officer erred in determining that the Appellant untimely appealed and did not show good cause to extend the 10-day filing deadline pursuant to *Montana Code Annotated* 39-51-2402(3) (16 days late to OAH).

#### Case # 00341-2026

<u>ISSUE:</u> Whether the Hearing Officer erred in determining that the claimant was unavailable for work and therefore ineligible from receiving benefits under *Montana Code Annotated* § 39-51-2104 during the period between June 22, 2025, and October 24, 2025, but is eligible to receive benefits beginning October 25, 2025 unless otherwise disqualified.

#### Case # 00318-2026

<u>ISSUE:</u> Whether the Hearing Officer erred in determining that the claimant is not qualified to receive unemployment insurance benefits based upon the separation from employment, i.e. leaving work without good cause attributable to the claimant's employment, pursuant to *Montana Code Annotated* § 39-51-2302 and Administrative Rules Montana 24.40.615.

## Case # 00282-2026

ISSUE: Whether the Hearing Officer erred in determining that the Appellant was not laid off as defined by Administrative Rules Montana 24.40.101(30) and (40) but instead is disqualified to receive benefits based upon the separation from employment, i.e. leaving work without good cause attributable to the claimant's employment, pursuant to *Montana Code Annotated* 39-51-2302 and Administrative Rules Montana 24.40.615.
